A conspicuous absence of movement on the Brigham City fault segment during the past 2,000 years suggests that the probability of a surface-faulting earthquake there may be greater than on other segments. There have been 4 in the past 6,000 years and none in the past 2,000, longer than any other time in the past 6,000 years.

When the "Big One" hits people would need public shelter during freezing temperatures. Most power, water and communications would be out initially, and may not be restored in some areas for months. Fires could be widespread. Police and firefighters will be so overwhelmed that they will not reach many people for days, so neighbors would need to rely on each other for help. Only those with training will be of much value. When it hits it will be too late to get the training.

EarthquakeTrake.com reports 48 earthquakes on the Brigham City segment alone in the past year!

We cannot underestimate the importance of emergency planning, nor can we assume we'll have ample warning time. When an emergency hits, preparation time is done, and our planning or lack thereof goes into action, and creates our future!
